1. SERVICE OFFERINGS

1.1. 1+ Dialing

Customers who have selected the Company as their presubscribed interexchange carrier utilize 1+ dialing for toll calls.

1.2. Calling Cards

The customer utilizes an 11-digit "800" access number established by the Company to access a terminal. Upon receiving a second dialtone, the customer uses push-button dialing to enter an identification code assigned by the Company, followed by the ten-digit number of the called party.

1.3. 800/888 Service (Toll Free)

This service is a direct access, incoming only, usage sensitive WATS offering which requires a dedicated access line for use. This is a service whereby a customer can be billed at reduced rates for calls to his premises.

1.4. Specialized Pricing Arrangements

Customized service packages and competitive pricing packages at negotiated rates may be furnished on a case-by-case basis in response to requests by customers to the Company for proposals or for competitive bids. Service offered under this tariff provision will be provided to customers pursuant to contract. Unless otherwise specified, the regulations for such arrangements are in addition to the applicable regulations and prices in other sections of the tariff. Specialized rates or charges will be made available to similarly situated customers on a non-discriminatory basis.

2. INTERLATA RATES

2.1. 1+ Dialing

(A) **Residential**

The Company will charge a flat rate per minute without regard to mileage for calls made by residential customers originating and terminating in California as follows:

(B) **Business**

The Company will charge a flat rate per unit without regard to mileage for calls made by business customers originating and terminating in California as follows:
